PORTIONS REMAIN IN THE SFHA

This document provides the Federal Emergency Management Agency's determination regarding a request for a Letter of Map Amendment for the property described above. Using the information submitted and the effective National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) map, we have determined that the described portion(s) of the property(ies) is/are not located in the SFHA, an area inundated by the flood having a 1-percent chance of being equaled or exceeded in any given year (base flood). This document amends the effective NFIP map to remove the subject property from the SFHA located on the effective NFIP map; therefore, the Federal mandatory flood insurance requirement does not apply. However, the lender has the option to continue the flood insurance requirement to protect its financial risk on the loan. A Preferred Risk Policy (PRP) is available for buildings located outside the SFHA. Information about the PRP and how one can apply is enclosed.

This determination is based on the flood data presently available. The enclosed documents provide additional information regarding this determination. Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Tract V, thence run N.53°48'12"E., 20.66 feet along the Northerly boundary of said Tract V to the Point of Beginning; thence continue along said Northerly boundary of Tract V, N.53°48'12"E., 420.03 feet to a point of curvature; thence Easterly, 54.98 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 35.00 feet and a central angle of 90°00'00" (chord bearing S.81°11'48"E., 49.50 feet); thence S.53°48'12"W., 21.45 feet; thence S.02°00'24"E., 353.42 feet to a point on a curve; thence Southerly, 33.69 feet along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 55.00 feet and a central angle of 35°05'48" (chord bearing S.15°32'30"W., 33.17 feet) to a point of tangency; thence S.02°00'24"E., 186.51 feet to a point of curvature; thence Southerly, 45.88 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 80.00 feet and a central angle of 32°51'31" (chord bearing S.14°25'22"W., 45.25 feet) to a point of tangency; thence S.30°51'07"W., 54.37 feet to a point of curvature; thence Southerly, 21.33 feet along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 70.00 feet and a central angle of 17°27'26" (chord bearing S.22°07'24"W., 21.25 feet) to a point of tangency; thence S.13°23'41"W., 48.71 feet to a point of curvature; thence Southwesterly, 18.50 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 30.00 feet and a central angle of 35°19'31" (chord bearing S.31°03'27"W., 18.20 feet) to a point of compound curvature; thence Southwesterly, 128.68 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 575.79 feet and a central angle of 12°48'16" (chord bearing S.55°07'21"W., 128.41 feet) to a point of compound curvature; thence Westerly, 75.57 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 75.00 feet and a central angle of 57°44'05" (chord bearing N.89°36'29"W., 72.42 feet) to a point of compound curvature; thence Northwesterly, 109.12 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 105.00 feet and a central angle of 59°32'39" (chord bearing N.30°58'06"W., 104.28 feet) to a point of tangency; thence N.01°11'47"W., 305.31 feet; thence N.04°48'57"W., 121.61 feet to a point of curvature; thence Northerly, 16.17 feet along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 60.00 feet and a central angle of 15°26'25" (chord bearing N.12°32'09"W., 16.12 feet) to a point of tangency; thence N.20°15'22"W., 39.76 feet to a point of curvature; thence Northwesterly, 34.60 feet along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 30.00 feet and a central angle of 66°04'24" (chord bearing N.53°17'34"W., 32.71 feet) to a point of tangency; thence N.86°19'46"W., 21.38 feet to the Point of Beginning
